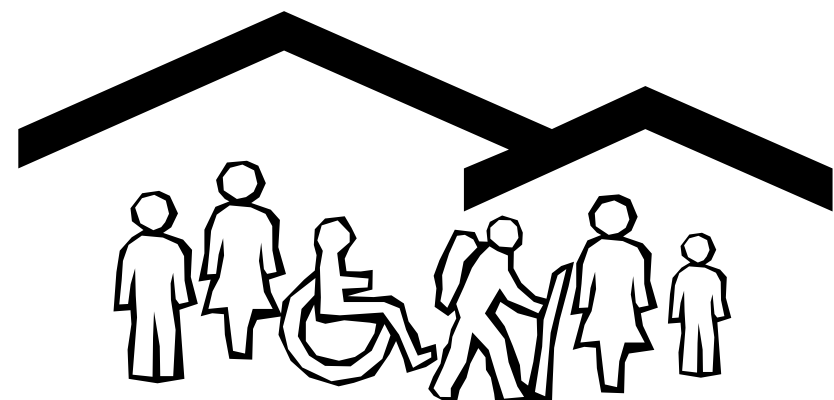


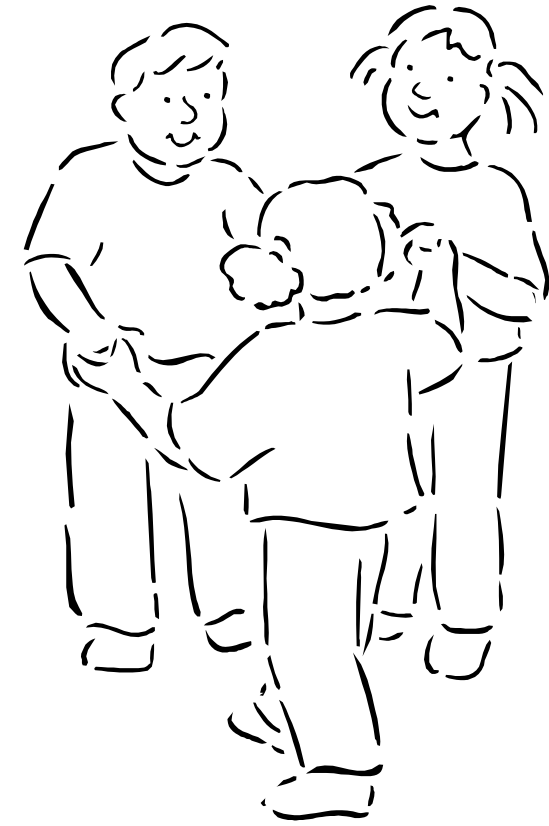
If someone tries to tell you and your family that you can't live where you choose they may be breaking the law. Fair Housing Laws make it illegal to tell people that they can't live where they choose because of the color of their skin, their race, the country they come from, their religion, because they are a boy or because they are a girl, because they have a disability or because there are kids in the family. If you live in California it is also illegal to treat people differently for other reasons that have nothing to do with your ability to pay rent or to be a good neighbor and renter.
